#### ORDER

- (1) In the circumstances reported by the Commandant General, Kerala Fire & Rescale Services and Director General of Police, Thiruvananthapuram in their letters read as 4th action to papers above respectively, Government are pleased to accord Administrative Sanctice to revive Home Guards in the State of Kerala as per Kerala Home Guards Act, 1960, as per Home Guards Rules 1960 and as amended vide G.O.(Ms)No.179/2009/Home, dated 12-11-2009
- (2) It is decided to implement the scheme as narrated below and as per Kerala Home Guards Amendment Rules, 2009.

# The Home Guards can be used for the following duties:-

- (i). Fire Fighting and Rescue Operations.
- (ii). Traffic Control and Regulations.
- (iii). Festival Bundobust.
- (iv). Functions Bundobust.
- (v). National Calamities Civil Defence Operations.
- (vi). Special Police Constables at the time of Election.
- (vii). Static Protection duties.
- (viii). Patrol Assistance.
- (ix). Community Policing.

## STRUCTURE OF HOME GUARDS.

- (3) A maximum strength of 3000 Home Guards have to be selected from thouse retired from Military, Navy, Airforce, Border Security Force, Central Reserve Police Central Industrial Security Force, National Security Guard, Sasthra Seema Bell, Assam P. Indo Tibetan Border Force, Police, Fire Force, Excise and Forest etc, after proper to verification of character and antecedents. They will function under Commandant Gene Home Guards, Civil Defence and Fire Services and his Subordinate Officers.
- (4) Each Home Guard will be given a rank, based on his / her educational professional qualifications as specified by Government. A stipend of Rs.250/- per day will be paid to the Home Guard on days for duty. They will not be eligible for any other allowance including TA, DA. They will be given uniforms as prescribed under Rules.
- (5) Each Home Guard normally gets called out for service about 180 days in a calendary year (not continuous).

### SELECTION PROCEDURE

- (6) The Assistant Divisional Officer of the Fire & Rescue Services Department in each District will be the co-ordinator. On duty they will be attached to the Fire and Rescue Stations Police Stations concerned. A Committee consisting of Assistant Divisional Office Superintendent of Police and District Sainik Welfare Officer concerned will select the Ho-Guards in each District. Physical efficiency test should be conducted for the selection of Home Guards. The eligibility prescribed is that one should qualify 100 metres run in 18 second or 3 km walk in 30 minutes. The youngest should be given priority. The candidates should medically fit and produce a fitness certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank Assistant Surgeon. The Assistant Divisional Officer will maintain a Nominal Roll of appointed candidate affixing their latest photograph and their contact phone number Assignment of duties to Home Guards personnel shall be done on rotational basis.
- (7) A Committee consisting of the following members will be constituted for reduced the grievances occurring in their recruitment:-
  - (i) The Commandant General, Kerala Fire and Rescue Services, (Chairman)
  - (ii) The Director (Technical), Kerala Fire and Rescue Services,
  - (iii) The Director, Sainik Welfare Department.
- (8) Selected Home Guards Personnel will have to undergo training for a period of week at Kerala Police Academy, Viyyur / Kerala Fire & Rescue Services Academy, Viyyu

#### PAYMENT

- (9) Funds will be allotted by Government in the concerned Heads of Piro & Services for meeting the expenses of Home Guards Organisation and this amount will operated by the Assistant Divisional Officer of the concerned district. They will make pay and and meet the expenses for their maintenance from this fund. The Assistant Divisional Officer will maintain Pay Roll and Registers furnishing the up to date details of expenditure toward this, promptly.
- (10) The maximum number of Home Guards personnel will be limited to 3000 (Three thousand) only and the expenditure for the financial year shall be limited to the Budger provision.
